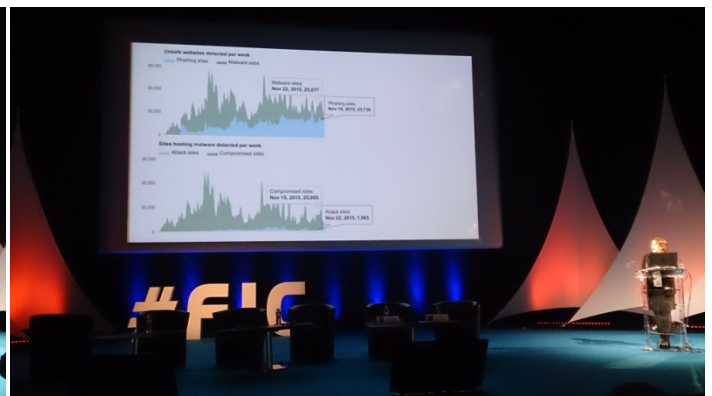


The so-called „Schloß Steinhöfel Seminar 2016“ of the Club R2GS German Chapter
